### **OUR COMMUNITY**

West Milford Township is a rural-suburban community of approximately 80 square miles, a mix of highlands, forest, lakes, open space, and residential neighborhoods. With a population of approximately 26,000, our demographically and socioeconomically diverse community includes professionals, skilled tradespeople, artisans, small business owners, and a myriad of other workers. Given our setting, many of our families and students enjoy outdoor activities (hiking, fishing, hunting, boating, swimming, skiing) in their free time. West Milford is the largest township in Passaic county - approximately 40 miles from New York City.

### **OUR SCHOOL**

West Milford High School has an enrollment of about 950 students. Many of our students will be first generation to attend college. WMHS is a comprehensive high school dedicated to provide an educational program suitable to the needs of our individual students. WMHS has a comprehensive college preparatory curriculum as well as strong programs in the skilled trades. A full continuum of services are available to our students with differing abilities. At WMHS we believe students should balance academics with participation in student activities - we offer 35 varsity sports, unified sports teams, special olympics, 9 honor societies, marching band, orchestra, choirs, theater program, and over 35 clubs/activities.

## CURRICULUM

West Milford High School requires students to complete a rigorous curriculum. Students are offered a comprehensive range of courses designed to address academic goals, learning needs, career interests and college plans. The school day is 8 periods, including lunch and physical education. Students in grades 9-12 are required to carry a minimum of 30 credits per year.
