

Applications for the 2025-2026 school year are available to West Milford District children who are 3 years of age on or before October 1, 2025 and are toilet trained. *PLEASE NOTE THERE ARE LIMITED SEATS AVAILABLE.*

What are the costs?

Total Tuition cost is **\$5,000.00 per year** and transportation is offered by the district to every student at no additional cost.

Upon acceptance, a **\$500.00 non-refundable deposit** must be submitted with the return of your contract. *(Please see the application process for further details)*

Application Process

- 1. Submit your application to the Office of Special Services, **no later than Thursday, March 27, 2025** to be part of the Lottery Drawing. Applications can be found at www.wmtps.org/Special Services/Inclusion Preschool Homepage. *A money deposit is not necessary with application*.
- 2. The 2025-2026 Lottery Drawing will occur on or after Friday, March 28, 2025.
- 3. Parents will be informed during the week of March 31, 2025.

Student Acceptance

If your student is accepted in the program, a contract will be mailed to you. All contracts and a **\$500.00** non-refundable deposit will be due to the Board of Education Office **no later than Friday, April 25, 2025.** The deposit will be applied towards the tuition.

Upon acceptance, all students must be registered in the district. All registration forms and health records must be completed online at <u>www.wmtps.org</u> and brought to Maple Road School or Marshall Hill School by **Friday, June 6, 2025**. An appointment is necessary. These forms are located on this website under For Families tab/Parent Resources/Student Registration Information. **Please Note**: Students will not be permitted to start school without all proper documentation.

The Inclusion Preschool Program runs 5 days per week (M, T, W, Th, and F). It is a half day program held from 12:15 pm to 2:50 pm each day. Please note the preschool programs are held at **Maple Road Elementary School and Marshall Hill Elementary School**.
